

**Establishment of Records Available to the Public**

Under section 71 of the Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act, RSBC 1996 c 165 (FOIPPA), and pursuant to my authority under that Act, in my capacity of Chair of the Board of Directors and acting upon its authority, I hereby establish the following as a category of records available to the public without a request under FOIPPA:

The final report prepared by the Royal BC Museum (RBCM) entitled Report to British Columbians and subsequent reports, responses, or documents developed as a result of the Report to British Columbians including, but not limited to, any progress reports which may be prepared by the RBCM to advise the public of the actions taken that are described or directly related to the actions described in the Report to British Columbians as well as any news releases, statements or additional publications by the RBCM regarding Report to British Columbians

Records falling within the above noted category, or information contained within those records, may or must be exempted from disclosure based on one or more of the following exemption criteria.

Exemption criteria

The above noted records must be exempted from disclosure, either in whole or in relevant part as appropriate, if they contain any of the following:

- Personal information, if the disclosure would constitute an unreasonable invasion of an individual's privacy;
- Information protected by solicitor-client privilege or any other privilege; or
- Third party business information that was provided in confidence and, if disclosed, would harm the third party's business interests.

The above noted records may be exempted from disclosure, either in whole or in relevant part as appropriate, if they contain any of the following:

- Other information that may or must be excepted from disclosure if the records were requested under Part 2 of FOIPPA, including information that would reveal cabinet confidences; or
- Information which should not be disclosed for other legal or compelling public interest reasons.
