BC Archives Research Guide

Old MS COLONIAL GOVERNOR RECORDS

This inventory provides a chronological list (by start date) of records related to the following colonial governors:

- Colony of Vancouver Island, 1849–1866 (Richard Blanshard, James Douglas, and Arthur Edward Kennedy)
- Colony of British Columbia, 1858–1866 (James Douglas and Frederick Seymour)
- the united Colony of British Columbia, 1866–1871 (Frederick Seymour and Anthony Musgrave)

The records were predominantly catalogued under a BC Archives system used from the mid-1930s to the early 1970s, known as the "Old MS" system. These records are only fully catalogued in the "Old MS" card catalogue, located within the BC Archives reference room. Additional relevant records will also be found within the Old MS card catalogue and the BC Archives Collection search.

Digital copies of <u>colonial despatches of Vancouver Island and British Columbia 1846-1871</u> have been made available by the University of Victoria.
