

## Chaperone Responsibilities

### RESTROOMS AND WATER

Restrooms are located on all levels. Drinking fountains can be found on the main and second floors.

### FIRST AID/SECURITY

## Prompts to encourage discussion in your group

- “Why do you think that is?/What do you see that makes you think that?”
- “What else do you notice?”

- Encourage discussion between the students and look at the panels and labels for hints if you need them. It’s okay, you don’t have to know all the answers.
