This permanent position as Vice President acts as the Museum's chief curator and Deputy CEO, second-in-command to the Chief Executive Officer (CEO), and serves as a key member of the executive. The incumbent will provide advice to the CEO on all matters relating to collections and will lead the development, articulation and delivery of the Museum's international strategy.

A highly creative, visionary thinker with at least 10 years' experience at a leadership level within a major collecting museum or cultural institution supervising over 20 professional staff; a proven commitment to excellence in exhibitions, learning, research and curation, institutional best practices, and the highest ethical standards; a strong network of peers at major museums or cultural centres, ideally around the world; familiarity with the representation of Indigenous issues in museums. You have the ability to communicate both orally and in writing in English, with a Master's degree or equivalent experience.

Consideration of candidates will begin immediately, and the new Vice President will start at a date mutually agreed upon. Salary will be based on qualifications \$124,000 to \$138,000 per year at 35 hours per week.
