## COLONIAL AND OTHER EARLY BIRTH, BAPTISM, MARRIAGE, AND DEATH RECORDS

Prior to British Columbia becoming a province in 1871, births, baptisms, marriages, deaths, and burials were often recorded with churches, with the Colonial Secretary for Vancouver Island, or with the Colonial Secretary for British Columbia. Some of these records can be found at the BC Archives. Church and diocese archives remain the only repositories of many such records, though the BC Archives may hold copies.

Even after 1871, many births, marriages, and deaths were not reported to and/or recorded by the government. Responsibility for reporting events to District Registrars fell primarily on family, clergy, and other individuals and participation varied. District Registrars were generally responsible for large areas of the province. Given the size of the province, scattered and migratory populations, the remoteness of many settlements, and transportation and communication challenges it is not surprising that some events were never reported. Consequently, other types of records can be an important source of information. For example, newspaper may have also recorded births, marriages, and deaths.

The list below is arranged by geographic location and includes records available at the BC Archives. Sometimes deaths that do not appear in the BC Archives <u>Genealogy Collection</u> can be found within coroner's records.
